Full Paper Submission Guidelines

Dear Author,

Congratulations! We are pleased to inform you that your paper has been accepted for presentation at the 2014 International Conference on Quality Engineering and Management, hosted by the University of Minho, Guimarães, in Portugal, September 14-16, 2014. We warmly invite you to submit your final paper.

Please note that your full paper submission will be included in the ICQEM 2014 conference proceedings, provided that it meets the ICQEM required standards and that:

- The full paper has been submitted no later than May 15, 2014.
- At least one of the authors has registered to attend the conference on or before May 15, 2014.

FULL PAPER SUBMISSION

Prior to submitting your full paper, please read carefully and adhere strictly to the following guidelines:

- Please submit your full paper no later than May 15, 2014. Please be aware that papers received after this date will not be included in the conference program and in the conference proceedings.
- The title of the full paper has to be identical with the one mentioned in the submitted abstract.
- As a guide, the paper overall length should not exceed 6000 words, including the abstract, all illustrations, tables, and references. Papers exceeding this limit will be returned to their corresponding author.
- Please submit your paper as a *word* document by e-mail to icqem@dps.uminho.pt
- Papers should be organized in the following sequence:
 - Article Title
 - Authors Details: Full name(s), Affiliation of each author, Email address of the corresponding author

- Abstract (not exceeding 250 words in total, including keywords and article classification)
- Keywords
- Article Classification
- Main subject text
- Acknowledgments (If applicable)
- References
- The main subject text can be organized in sections, such as:
 - Introduction: Theoretical background, managerial problem and research questions
 - Literature review/objectives and/or hypotheses.
 - Design/methodology/approach: How are the objectives achieved? Describe the main data and data sources as well as methods of data collection, analysis and validation.
 - Findings: Presentation and discussion of achieved or expected results.
 - Relevance/contribution: Highlight achieved or expected contribution to the theory, practice, methodology or teaching of OM.
- In preparing your full paper, please follow the ICQEM standard guidelines for layout, format and structure in addition to the full paper references.
- The full paper submitted must be an original work that had never been published before in their current or substantially similar forms or accepted for presentation at any other conference.
